Gun violence is a public health issue.

Every year, 30,000 Americans die from firearm injuries and 70,000 Americans are injured. Firearms are the second biggest killer of children in the US, responsible for 3000 child deaths each year; more children die from firearms than from cancer. In 2016, 1800 women were murdered by men; the most common weapon used was a gun. More than 20,000 Americans die of suicide by gun each year.
