This year's theme highlights a persistent challenge: too many people remain unaware of HPV, its link to several types of cancer, and the importance of HPV vaccination. A 2025 *Journal of the American Medical Association* news brief reported survey findings from 2017–2022 showing that 34% of respondents had never heard of HPV and nearly 38% had never heard of the HPV vaccine. Even more concerning, 28% did not know that HPV can cause cervical cancer, and 71% did not know that it can cause oral cancer.* Let's change those statistics by raising awareness and helping more people understand the role of HPV prevention in reducing cancer risk.
