## Leadership

2013 has been an exciting year under the leadership of AMWA Presidents Dr. Gayatri Devi (2012-13) and Dr. Eleni Tousimis (2013-14). Please enjoy this report highlighting AMWA's accomplishments over the past year.

## Human Trafficking Initiative

AMWA and Mt. Sinai Global Health co-hosted a 2-day training by Girl's Educational & Mentoring Services (GEMS) on the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC). AMWA has also partnered with filmmaker Stuart Culpepper to produce a nationwide media campaign to educate healthcare professionals about this issue. ## Gender Equity

AMWA's Gender Equity Task Force (GETF) continues to advocate for gender equity for women in medicine. Outcomes from their study, "Defining the Work Habits, Attitudes and Experiences of Women in Medicine" were presented at various meetings and summarized in a white paper. Focus group interviews are planned to study this area in more depth. The committee is also developing a Women in Crisis resource site and planning Advocacy Day 2014.

## 98<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Meeting in NYC

AMWA's 98th anniversary meeting in New York City was an unparalleled success! The speaker roster featured America's most accomplished physicians, all of whom were leaders within their field.

We were sold out at this packed event which featured top

quality CME sessions, mentoring programs, and 50 poster presentations. Dr. Nancy Andrews, Dean of Duke University School of Medicine, delivered the plenary address. Dr. Michelle Bachelet, the newly-elected president of Chile, was our keynote speaker at the Annual Awards Luncheon along with best-selling author, Calvin Trillin. AMWA's charitable arm, the American Women's Hospitals Service (AWHS) supports 10 medical facilities for the underserved. Recent work in 2013 includes:

- Helping to staff medical clinic boats that provide vital medical care to over 100,000 people a year along the Amazon River.
- Working to provide ongoing HIV, TB, diabetes, and inpatient care in Haiti through Hopital Bon Samaritain
- Supporting women's health and primary care programs of the Sisters of Charity in Topeka, Kansas at the Marian Clinic
- Providing improved clinic services, clean water supply, and remote health outreach to the people of Nepal
- Providing critical laboratory services in Ddegeya, Uganda
- Providing travel grants to students and residents serving in areas of need – Le Paz, Bolivia, Galle, Sri Lanka, Santa Cruz La Laguna, Guatemala, Kigali, Rwanda, & Choma Zambia
