



**AAOS Appropriate Use Criteria (AUC)  
Management of Postoperative Surgical Site Infections  
Voting Panel**

<b>Charges</b>	The voting panel will be given approximately one month to complete the first-round of voting individually using an electronic ballot. To complete the second round of voting, all voting panel members will be required to participate in a one day (7:30AM - 4 PM) in-person meeting in Rosemont, IL.
<b>Meeting Times</b>	Each voting panel member will be required to meet in person for a one day (7:30AM - 4 PM) meeting to discuss the group variances in the first-round ratings and to re-rate scenarios as they see fit. Travel, hotel, and meals will be paid for by the AAOS. Please keep in mind that we suggest that voting panel members fly in the night before the meeting and are free to leave after the meeting concludes (4 PM CT).
<b>Requirements of Voting Panel Members</b>	All voting panel candidates must be available to participate in the round two in-person discussion/voting. Voting panel members will be expected to use evidence (supplied to them via a systematic literature review assembled by AAOS staff) along with their expertise and experience to rate the appropriateness of treatment for various patient scenarios during two rounds of voting. Voting panel candidates must complete the AAOS enhanced disclosure form and cannot have any conflicts relevant to the AUC topic. If a voting panel candidate does have relevant conflicts, AAOS staff will contact the nominating society for another candidate.
<b>Voting Panel Submission Deadline</b>	Deadline for nominee submission is <b>Monday, May 21, 2018</b>
